



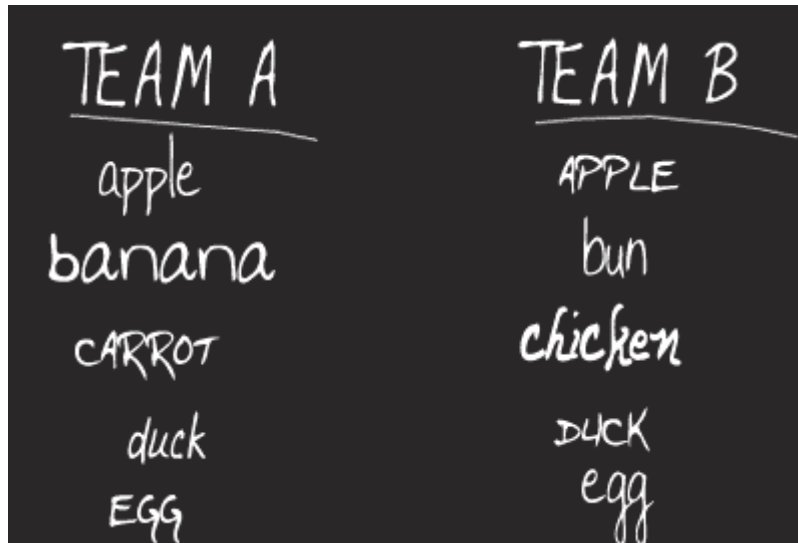

MacArthur Fellow and Harvard sociologist Matthew Desmond has forever changed the way we look at poverty in America. Desmond "set a new standard for reporting on poverty" (*The New York Times*) with his massively influential book *Evicted*, which gives pathos to the idea that eviction is a cause, rather than merely a symptom, of poverty. *Evicted* won the 2017 Pulitzer Prize and was named one of the Top Books of 2016 by *The New York Times*, *The Washington Post* and *The Wall Street Journal*. Desmond co-founded Just Shelter, a database of community organizations working to preserve affordable housing, prevent eviction and reduce family homelessness.
